This edition was finalised and approved after observation and recommendation by a departmental committee consisting of members from various specialization and experts (pharmaceutical) from relevant sections.

An essential drug list is a selection of high-quality, safe and cost-effective medicines chosen by health authorities to meet the most important healthcare needs of its population. The World Health Organization (WHO) provides a model list, but each country and each State develops its own based on its specific health burden, available resources, and healthcare priorities. These list are crucial for ensuring that basic healthcare is accessible and affordable for everyone.

This EDL 2025 edition consists of 285 medicines for District Hospitals, 238 for Community Health Centres, 160 for Primary Health Centres (HWC-PHC) and 86 for Sub Centres (HWC-SHC) respectively.

The aim and objective of this EDL is to ensure availability of drugs / medicines in all the Health Units of the State as prescribed.
